

Local Cuisine

Mauritian meals offer a vibrant fusion of Indian, Chinese, African, and European influences. Street foods include Dhall Puri (lentil-stuffed flatbread) and Boulettes (dumplings in broth). Main dishes feature rich curries (Cari), Biryani, and fresh seafood, alongside Chinese noodles (Mine Frites) and French-style pastries. Meals are often served with spicy chutneys and achars (pickles) adding even more flavour to the experience.

Popular Meal Types & Dishes

Indian-Influenced

- Dhall Puri/Roti: Thin pancakes or flatbreads stuffed with ground yellow split peas, served with curries and chutneys.
- Biryani: Fragrant spiced rice with meat or fish, a festive favorite.
- Vindaye (Vindaloo): A tangy, spicy curry with mustard, turmeric, and vinegar.
- Rougaille: A tomato-based sauce with onions, garlic, and spices, often with fish or meat.
- Samosas & Gateaux Piments: Savory fritters (chili cakes, vegetable fritters).

Chinese-Influenced

- Boulettes: Steamed dumplings (meat, fish, veggies) in broth.
- Mine Frites/Bouillie: Fried or boiled noodles with various toppings.
- Bol Renverse: Layered rice topped with an omelette.

Seafood

- Grilled fish, octopus salad (Salad Ourite), prawns, lobster, often cooked in Creole or curry style.

Snacks & Sides (Gajak)

- Deep-fried snacks like Gateaux Arouille (taro fritters).
- Achars (pickled vegetables) and coconut chutney.

Sweet Treats & Drinks

- Alouda: A refreshing milk-based drink with basil seeds and jelly.
- Napolitaine, Gato Coco, banana fritters.
- Local drinks and local tea.
- Fresh fruits and sugarcane juice.


Banking hours are usually from 09:00 to 15:15 hrs on weekdays. During weekends, banks are normally closed. Automated Teller Machines (ATMs) are widely available 24/7 across the country. Some money exchanges operate daily and during weekends.

Weather & Climate

Mauritius enjoys a tropical climate with two main seasons: a hot, humid summer and a cooler, drier winter. The island is also famous for its various microclimates, where weather conditions can change quickly over short geographical distances.

Key Characteristics

Year-Round Warmth: Temperatures are pleasant all year, rarely dropping below 17°C (63°F) or rising above 31°C (88°F).

Two Seasons: Summer is from November to April and a winter from May to October.

Microclimates: Due to a central plateau and mountains, one part of the island might be experiencing rain while another, only a few kilometers away, is sunny and dry. The north and west coasts are generally warmer and drier, while the east and south coasts are windier and cooler.

Abundant Sunshine: The island generally receives between 6.5 to over 8 hours of bright sunshine daily.

Seasonal Overview


Season	Months	Temperature (Coastal Average)	Key Weather Conditions
Summer	November - April	28°C - 33°C (82°F - 91°F)	Hot, humid, and the wettest season with occasional heavy, short-lived showers, often in the afternoon. Tropical cyclones are possible, particularly from January to March, which can bring heavy rain and strong winds for a few days if they pass near the island.
Winter	May - October	22°C - 28°C (72°F - 82°F)	Cooler, drier, and less humid. Southeast trade winds are most consistent, making the east and south coasts feel windier (good for kitesurfing). The north and west coasts offer the best beach weather during this time as they are more sheltered.



A Robust Regulatory Framework for Quality and Trust

Mauritius offers a well-regulated, transparent, and internationally aligned higher education ecosystem that safeguards quality, integrity, and learner confidence. The sector is overseen by the Ministry of Tertiary Education, Science and Research through independent statutory bodies responsible for regulation, quality assurance, and system development, namely the Higher Education Commission (HEC) and the Quality Assurance Authority (QAA).

The HEC, established under the Higher Education Act 2017, is the national regulator for higher education. It registers and accredits institutions, recognises local and foreign qualifications, approves micro-credentials, promotes research, allocates public funding, and guides sector planning to ensure relevance, efficiency, and lifelong learning.

Quality assurance is strengthened by the Quality Assurance Authority (QAA), a statutory body mandated to uphold and enhance academic standards across the system. Following legislative reforms in 2025, the QAA is responsible for developing and maintaining the Mauritius Higher Education Quality Code, conducting quality audits, and aligning national practices with international benchmarks.

Quality assurance is further reinforced through strong international regulatory cooperation, including the UK Quality Assurance Agency (QAA) and France's HCERES, supporting globally benchmarked standards and streamlined accreditation for international campuses.

Together, the HEC and the QAA ensure that Mauritius delivers high-quality, globally recognised education in a safe, multicultural, English- and French-speaking environment.







Communication (Mobile & Internet) - The international dialling code for Mauritius is +230. Mobile and internet services are reliable, with good roaming coverage. SIM cards and data packages are easily available from local outlets.

Time Zone - Mauritius operates on GMT+4, which is important to consider when planning travel or international communication.

Power Supply - Electricity is 240 volts at 50 Hz, and electrical sockets are Type G and Type C, with Type G being the most commonly used.

Water Quality - Tap water in Mauritius meets World Health Organization standards and is generally safe to drink.

Language - English is the official language of Mauritius, used in government and education. French is also widely used, mainly for media and business. Mauritian Creole is the most commonly used language in daily life. The island's rich cultural heritage is reflected in several other languages across the community.



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
